- 2. Other items

Ms. O'Hagan asked if the trustees had any questions regarding Item A below. Mr. Vulpis asked about the time frame to conduct such investigation and it was confirmed it is within 30 days of receipt. Ms. O'Hagan then asked for a motion to approve Item A.

## A. Approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, a petition was received by the District Clerk on April 18, 2022 seeking to create a child safety zone pursuant to Education Law Section 3635-b (See copy annexed hereto), and

WHEREAS, Section 3635-b of the Education Law requires such a petition to be submitted no later than March 1 in order to permit the required investigation prior to finalization of the succeeding annual District election ballot, thereby rendering submission of any proposition contemplated by this petition unable to be included in this year's annual District election, and

WHEREAS, the required investigation of whether the area identified is capable of being designated a child safety zone under the regulations of the Commissioner of Transportation is required to be conducted within thirty (30) days of receipt of such a petition received after March 1, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the proposition contemplated by the petition will not be included in the May 17, 2022 election, and be it further

RESOLVED, that Board of Education will report the results of its investigation within thirty (30) days of receipt of the petition

3. Ms. O'Hagan asked for a motion to adjourn. Upon motion made by Mr. Vulpis, seconded by Mr. DeMatteo, and passed unanimously, the Special Meeting was adjourned at 4:39 p.m.
